Marqués de Valparaíso Ribera del Duero Roble

A modern winery founded in 2000 in Quintana del Pidio, Burgos, in the heart of the Ribera del Duero appellation. The estate owns 154 acres of vineyards planted primarily with Tempranillo grapes from which all the wines are made. The vines vary from 15 years to over 100 years in age.

The region's continental climate ensures long, cold winters and short, hot summers, which help ripen the fruit while maintaining a freshness in the wines. Fermentation is traditional “bordelais” style in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks and the aging is carried out in American and French oak barrels.

Grape varieties: 100% Tempranillo

Tasting notes: Bright, cherry red color. Fruity bouquet of red berry fruits with smoky hints from the oak. On palate, the red cherry comes through with a background of vanilla and a touch of spice. Round tannins, easy to drink with good length.

Aging: Five months, half in French barriques and half in American oak.

Food pairing: Meats, cheeses and pasta dishes.

Alcohol content: 14.5% by vol.

Formats: 750ml/12 Bottles

Serving temperature: 60-62°F
