The botanical drink

Botanical Liqueur

Notes: Created in 1924, the name “Kranabet” comes from the word “kraneweta” which in the Cimbrian language means “bitter grains” which was the name for the Juniper plant in ancient pre-alpine times.

The proprietary recipe is a distillate based primarily from Juniper berries with other botanicals including gentian roots, roman absinthe, coriander and quassia bark. A copper pot still with bain-marie system is used to maximize the all-natural aromatics and flavors of the botanicals.

Aromatic and persistent flavor of Juniper with delicate bitter and herbaceous notes attained from the complementary botanicals. Enjoyed as a shooter, neat or in cocktails such as the signature drink “KranabeTonic” which is simply 1 part Kranabet and 3 parts tonic water built in a highball with ice.
