TASTING NOTES:

The nose shows early gentle spices and warms to a juicy sweet barley style. On the palate detect those now somewhat “fizzing” spices with autumnal fruits and rich cereal tones – all neatly being wrapped up similarly in the finish.

KEY USPs:

- No colouring
- No chill-filtration
- Bottled at high alcohol strength (46%)

Clan Denny presents true variety with expressions from a range of Distilleries across Scotland’s Whisky regions featuring age statements spanning from 7 to 50 years old. Each bottling is from one single cask, and is presented to you without colouring or chill-filtering the spirit, allowing the true character to shine through.
