"Very pure in feel, with a beam of warm cassis, plum reduction and boysenberry preserves running the full length of the wine, finishing with licorice snap and warm earth hints. Gains density in the glass too." - JM

## AGING

In normal years, it will develop for 15-20 years; in exceptional years, up to a century. Once open, drink within 1 day (old ports) or 1 week (young ports).

*Store bottles on their sides, in a cool, dry place (16°C) and away from any direct light. Serve at 18°C and decant.*
