# **A PAGHAS**

A PACHAS is Madrid Spanish slang meaning "to share." The brand name is easy to translate to several languages and it is a concept that is easy to transmit. In an abstract way, the labels of the wines in the range, show people having a good time sharing a glass of wine.



A Pachas was founded by a Father-and-Son team with decades of experience in the Spanish wine business. The wines are from the Madrid D.O. and are produced under the direction of renowned wine-maker Jaime Alvarez Pastor. The artwork for the labels depicting "sharing" of the wine was created by artist and wine-maker Carlos Estecha.



## A PACHAS MAIVAR

Malvar is a Spanish white varietal that was nearly extinct until efforts to preserve it were made in 2001. It is a medium-bodied aromatic white with an herbal bouquet and acidic fruit notes. Fragrant and flavorful with a pleasant finish.





# A PACHAS TEMPRANILLO

This Madrid Tempranillo is ruby red in color with an intense nose of red fruits. Balanced with good tannin and fruit, it is medium in body with a bright finish.





### A PACHAS CRIANZA

This Tempranillo comes from 3O+ year old vineyards in the Madrid D.O. and is aged for 8 months in medium-toasted American oak barrels. Deep cherry in color, with an intense and complex aromas showing mature fruits and spices. Balanced and elegant with firm tannic structure and a lasting finish.





#### A PACHAS RESERVA

Aged for 18 months in American oak barrels, this wine exudes a deep ruby color with hints of garnet at the rim.



Pair with grilled lamb chops or aged cheese.
